- Gather detailed product information for classification process
- Application of Binding Tariff Information
- Set-up and maintain accessible archiving system (documentation and electronically)
- Check changes in European legislation or internal changes (e.g. new material) and execute adjustments
- Update and maintenance of condition and master tables in SAP
- Guarantee consistency master data between FE SAP and Logistics Service Providers systems
- Maintenance of SAP info-records (import-duty rates)
